There is no cell phone reception along the Icefields Parkway. Turn off your device and enjoy the views.

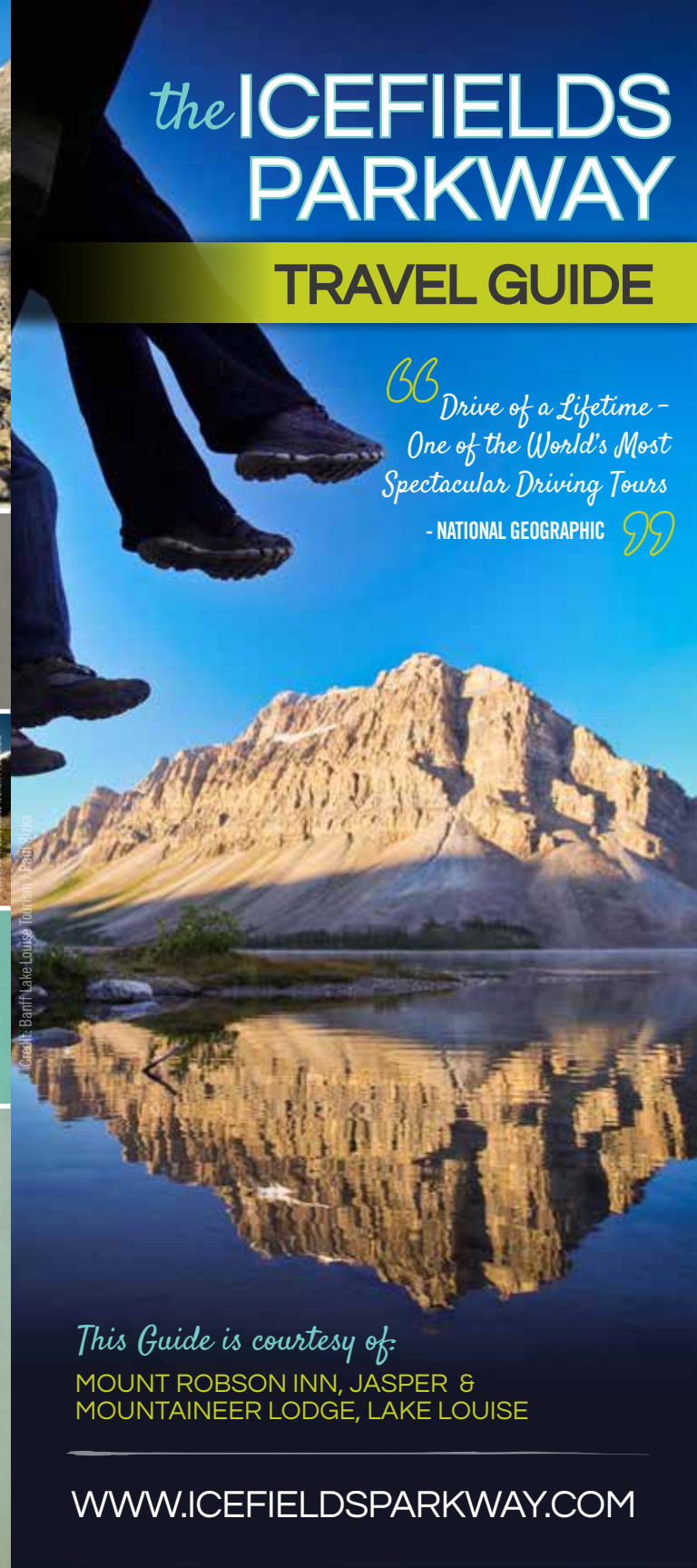

**FOR WINTER TRAVEL**  
(mid October to mid May),
